Appointments are not necessary for this clinic as part of the Saskatchewan Health Authority's (SHA) school-based vaccine clinic program. Information about this clinic was sent home with every student who is 12 years of age or older.

Please note that clinics may not be held at every school or community within the school division. The SHA is working with schools to determine how to ensure all students aged 12 and up have access to a vaccination.

Additional options are available for students who are home-schooled, for students who wish to access immunization sooner, or if parents wish to accompany their child to their appointment. These options include:

- Any [participating pharmacy](#) in Saskatchewan;
- By attending a [drive-thru or walk-in clinic](#) - note that these clinics will operate on reduced schedules in June in order to support school-based immunization during the week days;
- [Online booking](#) is available 24 hours per day, 7 days per week; or
