New COVID Measures For All Regina Public Schools

Regina Public Schools is committed to the health and safety of students, their families, and employees. As of November 29th, 2021, proof of vaccination, or recent negative COVID-19 test, is required for all who enter a Regina Public School, including McDermid. **This requirement does not apply to students.** It <u>does</u> apply to all employees, contracted individuals, volunteers, parents, and care givers. Valid proof of vaccination includes a vaccination certificate from a MySaskHealthRecord (printed or electronic) and review of an individual's ID. Please contact the school office if you have questions.

Cold Weather Protocols

Fresh air, exercise, and free play are an important part of a child's development. Students will be sent out for recess three times a day unless the weather is colder than -25 Celsius. We ask that even on nicer days, students are sent to school with warm coats, toques, mitten, ski pants, and boots. Even on a warm day, pants can get wet which will give students a chill or make them uncomfortable.






Parents/Guardians are invited to get involved with the McDermid School Community Council (SCC). New members are always welcome!
