2021/2022 School Year Pre-K and Kindergarten Registrations!

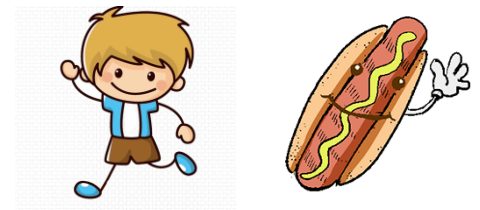
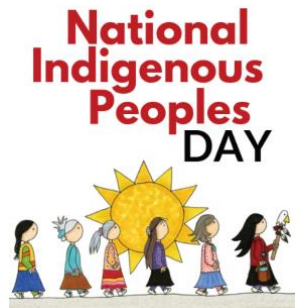
